

Minutes of December 11, 2008

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m.

Treasurer's Report: Mike Clark

Mike Clark handed out and reviewed the Quarterly Report.

Motion made, accepted and passed to accept the Treasurer's Report

Mike gave an overview of all of the investments and informed member if he was to roll over the *KSBCD#2* to a five year plan it would earn 4.11% interest with a 4.2 % yield per year.

Motion made, accepted and passed to roll over the KSBCD#2 for a five year plan at 4.11% with a 4.2 % yield per year.

Superintendent's Report: Dave Richmond

Project updates:

- 1 Re-roofing project at Civic Center Drive are complete.**
- 2. Overlay in Q section is complete.**
- 3. Stone raising and re-aligning is sections A & B is complete.**
- 4. Carillon at Civic Center Drive:** Members had approved \$5,000 in a previous meeting for repairs. Dave has contacted the appropriate company do a site visit for \$433. This amount is for the first hour after that it is going to cost \$33.00 for every ¼ hour. Dave is concerned that the repairs may exceed the approved amount and asked members how to proceed if that happens. Members discussed this at length and decided to have Dave get a price for the repairs and if it is too expensive they will look for cheaper alternatives before proceeding with the repairs.

Mike Murphy said other cemeteries have much smaller higher tech ways of playing the chimes and music out on the grounds. He said if Dave gives him the specifications of what he is looking for he will get some information together for an updated piece of equipment.

Pending Federal Grants:

- 1. Niche expansion in Caribou.**
- 2. Construction of a niche at Civic Center Dive (not approved yet).**
- 3. Construction of a committal shelter in Springvale.**

Liability of damaged items sold by the Association:

Dave discussed the issue of items getting damaged and who would be responsible for paying for repairs and/or replacement. Members agreed that it was their responsibility and would set up a maintenance fund.

*Motion made, accepted and passed to establish an account for repairs.
(The interest from the First TR Four account brings in approximately \$50.00 a month and that interest will be put in the maintenance fund account).*

Peter wanted to ask all Chairmen of the different Associations to meet and assist him with ideas that would bring in dedicated revenue to the cemetery.

Mike Murphy suggested opening themselves up to operating a crematory in one of the cemeteries. There are very few in the state and he feels it would be an excellent way to generate funds for the state cemeteries.

Peter asked Dave to thank the Association for all of their help this past year.

Gary informed members that the Woman's Veterans of America and the Waves have shown an interest in becoming members of the Association. He asked if there was any objection to that or if the Bylaws would prohibit them from becoming members. The general consensus was that it would be acceptable. Gary wants to increase members to enhance the Association.

Marvin feels that the Association should allow the Combat Vets to participate as well.

After the holidays Marvin will begin working on fundraising for the Battle Cross Monument. It will be placed at the Mt. Vernon Road Cemetery in the flag circle. Mike will make flyers and Marvin will approach businesses and group for donations.
